

A cheap & easy way to add some Japanese feel to your classroom windows and doors!

Things you need:

- book covering contacts
(white & timber pattern)
- scissors
- tape measure (optional)
- Stanley knife (optional)



1. Apply the white contact sheet onto the window. Make sure the window is clean before you do this. You can either measure the size of the window and cut the sheet beforehand, or cut excess with Stanley knife later.



2. Cut the timber pattern sheet into strips and apply them on the white surface to make it look like a wooden grid. Google "障子" to see the example images if you wish.
